THIRD MEETING OF THE PROJECT

The third meeting of Keep On Project was held in Vienna, Austria, between 6 and 7 November of 2017. During this meeting, partners reviewed the progress of the outputs and the activities carried out since June, and agreed the steps to follow in order to accomplish the goals of the Project.



Regarding the progress of the project to date, there was presented the final version of the Online Digital Database, as well as the development of the provisional versions of Training Curriculum, the Pedagogical Handbook, which will be a valuable guide for educators to get an overview of the main approaches and methodologies used to prevent cases of dropout, and the Toolbox for Professionals, with 20 tools aimed to give the best guidance for professionals in education to deal with issues such as educational counselling and support, dropout prevention and Interculturality in education.

Tasks and provisional products for the next months and next meeting were defined, specifically the Piloting Sessions with professionals and migrants and the development of the Staff Training activity (Capacity Building), which will be the main topics for the next project meeting in Heraklion, Greece, in February 2018.
